

CRAZY QUILT CLASS

Darcey and Jeannie will be demonstrating various flowers you can use in your piece.

WHERE: UNITED PRESBYTERIAN CHURCH

OPTIONAL: A kit will be available to purchase for \$12 prior to class.

In this class we're going to make a block which you will piece prior to class. Use the paper piecing method – you will be sewing on CHEAP muslin for the base – this should be at least two inches larger on each side than your foundation block. Use neutral colors (i.e. whites, creams, pastels), a mixture of solids and muted prints to piece this foundation. You can use cotton fabrics for your second piece or you can use the fancy fabrics that are in the kit (if you decided to purchase one). Use about 4-5 different fabrics and balance them out in your block. If you decide to use the fancy fabrics, you'll want to put a light-weight fusible behind the thinner pieces of fabric prior to piecing.

SUPPLIES:

Bring your pieced block

Bring a "doodle" cloth to practice stitches on

Embroidery needles – Milliners 4,7, 10

Chenille 18-24's

Beading needle #12

Tapestry needle 22, 24

Needle threader

Pin cushion or piece of felted wool

Small scissors

Pencil or gel pens that disappear with iron

Large hoop or Q snap frame so you don't have to move your piece around

Threads – embroidery floss, perle cotton – sizes 8 and 12, valdani, beading a ding thread or a thin thread that will go thru your needle and beads

Silk ribbon – 4 mm is the most common

Buttons

Charms

Lace

Ric rack

Sequins
