Supply List

- ☐ Sewing Machine - don't forget cords and foot pedal
- ☐ Pattern: "Pineapple Day Quilt" This is a free download from Fat Quarter Shop online - download before class and bring it with you - text me if you can't get it for some reason and I'll bring a pattern for you.
- ☐ Pineapple foundation paper pads by It's So Emma.....one pad each of the 12" and 6" size
- ☐ Rotary Cutter - With a new or sharp blade
- ☐ Cutting mat
- ☐ Rulers – bring one for strip piecing and a smaller size such as a 4" x 8" ...3.5" x 12.5" ...etc
- ☐ A post card
- ☐ Size 90/14 sharp or quilting sewing machine needles
- ☐ Add-a-quarter rulers... 6" and 12"
- ☐ A pop-up trash bucket would be helpful or a trash bag to tape to your table
- ☐ Spray Starch
- ☐ Seam Roller - my favorite is by Lori Holt
- ☐ Fabric glue stick
- ☐ Thread - neutral shade
- ☐ Basic sewing supplies - pins, scissors, extra blades, seam ripper, paper scissors, thread nippers, awl, extra sewing machine needles, etc.

Fabric requirements: The pattern calls for a jelly roll and 3 charm packs. But you can also use fat eights, fat or straight quarters, a layer cake or scraps. The more variety the better for a scrappy look.

Background: The pattern calls for 5.5 yards. This includes the border. You may choose to make fewer blocks for a smaller quilt....or just the 12" or 6" for a one size block quilt, or just a table runner.

Pre-class Homework: Spray starch all your fabric before coming to class and before cutting your strips. If using a jelly roll you can spray starch these as well. The strips will shrink slightly in length but not in width. Don't skip this step! This is VERY helpful when paper piecing strips.

Pre-class cutting: The 12" blocks call for 2.5" wide strips. The 6" blocks call for 1.5" wide strips. Have a good variety of these cut before class.
