

10" block (10½" unfinished)

Colors: A = Christmas Green, B = Christmas Red, C = Holiday Motif/Novelty

CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS:

A = Green - cut 8 (eight) squares 3"X 3".

B = Red – cut 4 (four) squares 3"X 3".

And cut 2 (two) squares 3½"X 3½". Mark diagonally and cut.

C = Holiday Motif - cut 1 (one) square 4"X 4". If directional, fussy cut on point.

ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS:

Row one is A/A/B/A squares.



For rows two and three, sew four red triangles on to the motif square. Trim/Square to 5½ inches. This will be the center square.

Watch placement of triangles if using directional fabric.



Sew two A/B pairs. If using directional fabric, place one A over B and the other B over A.



Assemble two center rows per image. A over B on the left side and B over A on the right side of the center square.

Row four is A/B/A/A squares.



Refer to image above for layout and final assembly.

Do not trim, leave unfinished.
